Please **do not** light fires or barbecues:

- During a prolonged dry spell or high fire risk warning;
- In forests or on moors;
- On farmland where there are crops or livestock;
- Near buildings or cultural heritage sites.



Fires and barbecues in the wrong place can cause serious damage to our countryside and farmland, and can result in the death of wildlife and livestock.

Please be a responsible countryside visitor and use a stove for outdoor cooking. **Remember to leave no trace.**
