The Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005

Screening Determination under Section 8(1)

Section 8 (1) of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 requires Local Authorities to determine if a plan is likely to have significant environmental effects.

Aberdeenshire Council has determined, in consultation with the Scottish Environment Protection Agency. Scottish Natural Heritage and Historic Scotland, that the Banff & Macduff Landscape/Environment Improvement Strategy is likely to have a significant effects and that a strategic environmental assessment is required.

An environmental report will be prepared alongside the Banff & Macduff Landscape/Environment Improvement Strategy Document. The environmental report will identify, describe and evaluate the likely significant effect on the environment of the implementing the Banff & Macduff Landscape/Environment Improvement Strategy and its reasonable alternatives as by the 2005 Act.
